UNSURE HOW TO DO THIS...?

1. Log into your school email. Go up to the right upper side of the page and click on the 9 small grey squares. Click on it.
2. A drop down menu will appear. Click on “sites” at the bottom left hand corner.
3. On the left hand side of the page is a button marked “create.” If you are already familiar with google sites, than you can create your own template. However, if you think you may struggle with this, browse the gallery for more pre designed templates.
4. Name your site and click “create.”
5. To edit your site, click on the “pencil” at the top of the site. It will allow you to change specific things about your page.
6. If you wish to change the actual format of your website, go up to the top right hand corner of the site and click on the gear.
 - a. You can even choose “edit site layout” to update the layout of your website.
 - b. “Manage website” under the gear will aid in changing font as well
7. To include a picture, click “Insert” and Picture. Once the picture has been inserted, you can change its size by clicking S, M, or L.
 - a. For pictures, you may use your phone or use the art department camera.
8. Play around with the google app to see what you can do!
9. Make sure to include the images and information necessary.
