- Provide TWO sentences for each element of art and principle of design, describing how it is being used. (Example: - *"The element of art, line, can be observed in this picture through the repetition of thick lines in the man's tie and the outline that surrounds all shapes. Thin diagonal lines can also be found beside the man's tie).*
